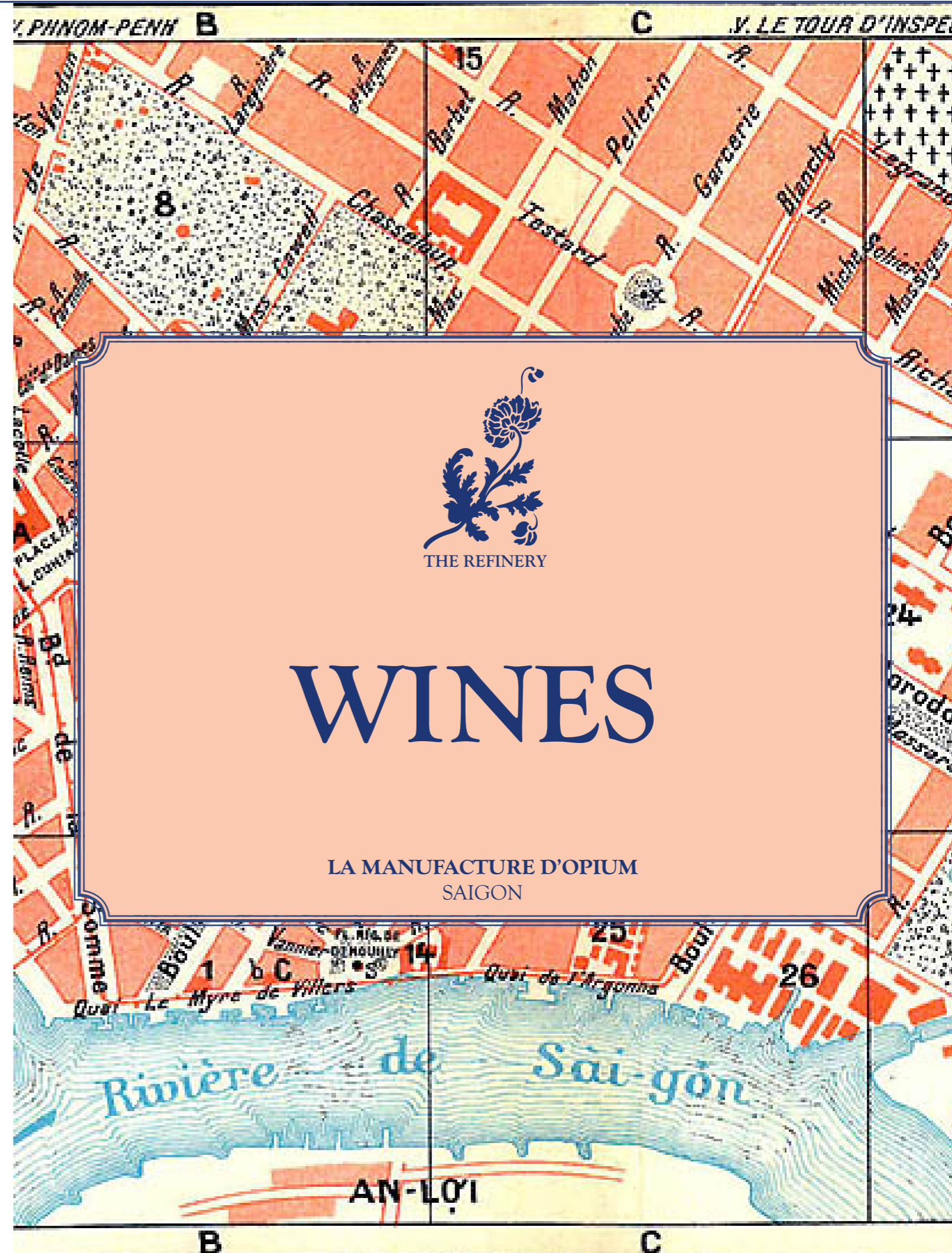

PINOT NOIR

Pinot noir grapes (cépage) produce a style of wine that is typically medium-dry and fruit-forward. With medium acidity and low to medium tannins, the wine is particularly balanced. Originally from Burgundy in France, the grape is notoriously hard to grow but does quite well on New-Zealand soils.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON & BORDEAUX BLENDS

Cabernet sauvignon is one of the most popular cépages. It's best known in the Bordeaux region of France, hence the common "Bordeaux blend" reference when it is used. The wine tends to be robust with medium acidity and tannins and flavors of rich, dark fruit. It is dry and medium to full-bodied. Aromas of tobacco and leather are often present.
